

## **DECEMBER 2018 PROJECT UPDATES ON THE WOMEN'S PIGGERY PROJECT IN NAMA SUB-COUNTY, MUKONO DISTRICT**

### **1.0 Introduction**

This December brief highlights the activities carried out on the Women's Piggery Project in Nama Sub-county, Mukono District. It focuses mainly on creation of a new group and major updates from other groups.

### **2.0 Creation of a new group**

Nezikokolima Gali Magi Women's Group was formed as a break away from John Paul II Women's Group in Wakiso village. A number of discussions were made to ensure that the already existing infrastructure in terms of a pig house should not be left unused. It was agreed that these women be encouraged to work together to use the facility with some support from the project.

### **3.0 Major updates**

#### *3.1 Kwagalana Women's Group*

The group sold two pigs which earned them UGX 310,000/=. They opened an account with DFCU Bank of UGX 60,000/= The pigs were sold because they failed to conceive. They were advised to replace them with another good breed. They promised to find replacements in January.

#### *3.2 John Paul II Women's Group*

Through a telephone call, the group leader reported that they have 17 new piglets after 2 of their females delivered. This happened after the visit. They have been advised to sell off some of them since they may not manage to feed this number. However, they should report on the proceeds made from the pigs as well as the expenses made.
